## SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE

There will be four (4) categories: Superior Performance, Veteran Superior Performance, Meritorious Service and Industry Partner. Eligibility: Candidates shall be chosen on the basis of playing ability, integrity, sportsmanship, character, and contribution to the game of bowling in general and outstanding service to the game of tenpins over a period of at least ten years.

1. Member of the Morris County USBC WBA in good standing for a minimum of 10 years.
2. Must have participated in 12 County Tournaments (Annual Championship, Queens/Princess and/or Elite)
3. Point System – need a minimum of **400** points to be eligible.
4. The Morris County USBC WBA Board of Directors and Hall of Fame Committee Members will elect members to the Morris County USBC WBA Hall of Fame by secret ballot. Voting: Each voting member shall be entitled to vote for not more than three (3) candidates in Superior Performance, two (2) candidates in Veteran Superior Performance, three (3) candidates in Meritorious Service and one (1) candidate for Industry Partner. Candidates receiving at least 55% of the returned ballot votes in each category will be inducted into the Morris County USBC WBA Hall of Fame.
5. The committee shall return credentials to the unsuccessful candidates and the person who submitted them so they can update and resubmit for future consideration. The current chairperson shall provide the Association Manager with copies of all credentials for the county office immediately following the selection of the inductees. Therefore, the Association Manager must keep any names submitted on file until the next Hall of Fame.
